- Demonstrated leadership and moral qualities of personal integrity, professional competence, service excellence and courage of conviction resulting in positive influences on Liberians and making a difference in the lives of others.
- Inspirational values of discipline, commitment, perseverance and hard work, balancing success in one's career or business and leading an exemplary family life thereby setting a good example for others to follow.

Awards and Recognition categories

- Outstanding FSLB Award - distinctly awarded to Liberians / others who, in their place of work or residence in Liberia or another country, have rendered valuable services for the promotion of basketball or youth activities / development.
- Most Outstanding FSLB Award – awarded to Liberians / others who have attained the highest national and / or international prestige, thereby
